

“LUCIANO CARUGO” TROPHY - 13th Edition
MEMORIAL “CESARE PELTI”, “MARCO INVERNIZZI”
AND “NONNA ENRICA” E “GUIDO FRANCONIERI”
International basketball tournament reserved to players under 18 years

REGULATION

ART. 1

The VICTOR RHO basketball club (in the following named “Victor Rho”), supported by the councils of the town of Rho and of the district of Milan and under the aegis of the Italian Basketball Federation, will organise an international basketball tournament reserved for boys. The matches will take place in the gymnasiums addressed as follows:

- Rho (Milano): "San Carlo" di via Bettinetti, 60;
- Rho (Milano): Molinello di via Trecate;
- Nerviano (Milano): via Roma;
- Arluno (Milano):palestra Damiano Chiesa.

during the following period: from 20th April to 25th April 2005.

ART. 2

The main goal of the tournament is promoting the relationship and the friendship among the players, to be obtained independently by the match's results.

The offered trophies as prizes are entitled in memory of the Luciano Carugo, Cesare Pelti Marco Invernizzi, Nonna Enrica and Guido Franconieri , friends of the "Oratorio S.Carlo".

ART. 3

The tournament is addressed to **players born in the years 1987, 1988** who are members of their own National Basketball Federation.

The following documents will have to be shown for each player:

1. the National Federation Card, testifying the membership to the Society for the sporting season 2004/2005;
2. the identity card or the passport, for foreigner clubs.

Any exception to this provision will not be admitted.

ART. 4

The participating teams are allowed to enter no more than 12 (twelve) players.

The teams are furthermore allowed to players becoming from other basketball societies, for all the tournament duration. These players will be provided of the specific pass of their original society; their names will have to be officially declared before the beginning of the tournament.

Any exception to this provision will not be admitted.

As an exception of the executive regulation, the team accompanying person is allowed to sit with the players during the match.

ART. 5

The tournament will join together for invitation 13 teams which will be divided into 4 groups named respectively memorial “Cesare Pelti”, memorial “Marco Invernizzi” , memorial “Nonna Enrica” and memorial “Guido Franconieri”.

Every team will meet the others of its group; at the end the team with more victories will be appointed the winner of the memorial in which it will be located.

In case of victories tie, the classification will be established second this points:

- a) direct match;
- b) difference of points in direct match;
- c) less points taken in direct matches;
- d) more points made in direct matches;
- e) better percentage in free throws;
- f) draw.

Into quarterfinals the first and the second classified in each group. With draw points the classification will be established second points rate, and with another draw, the organization will go on with a drawing.

Quarterfinals will be compose with the plan down reported:



with single match to come until the final.

The 9th/10th place final will be played by the 1st and 2nd best third classified in the group by points rate obtained versus the first and the second classified in the own group , and with points rate draw , by a drawing.

The 11th/12th place final will be played by the other two third classified in the initial group.

The matches will meet the regulation of the Italian Basketball Federation.

All the teams must be supplied with two sets of numbered jerseys of different colours. If two matching teams have the jerseys of same (or similar) colours, the team having passed more time from the last played match will be compelled to change the jerseys.

ART. 6

a) *PLAYING PARTS*

The matches will be based on four quarters of 10 (ten) minutes each (stopping the time when the ball is not active), and an interval of 10 (ten) minutes between the 2° and the 3° quarter and one minute between the 1° and the 2° and between the 3° and the 4° quarter;

b) *TIME OUTS AND CHANGES*

Two (2) time outs are available for each team in every moment in the first half (first and second period), three (3) time outs are available in every moment in the second half (third and fourth period) and one (1) time out is available for each extra time.

Time outs are available when:

- Ball becomes died, cronowatch is stopped and referee had finished to communicate with the official's table.
- For the team that endures a basket, in the same time a basket is scored.

Time outs become not available when:

- Ball goes into the hands of a player for the first or the only free trow.
- Ball goes into the hands of a player for a trow in.

Changes are available when:

- Ball becomes died, cronowatch is stopped and referee had finished to communicate with the official's table.
- For the team that endures a basket, in the same time a basket is scored in the last two minutes of the fourth period or extra time.

Changes become not available when:

- Ball goes into hands of a player for the first or the only free trow.
- Ball goes into the hands of a player for a trow in.

c) *BALL*

Material: true leather; size: no. 7; make: Spalding.

ART. 7

All types of defense will be admitted.

For the 24 seconds rule, the article no. 18 of FIBA Official Regulation will be applied (for national championship)

ART. 8

The Italian Basketball Federation will provide the official referees for every played match.

ART. 9

The organising committee of the “Luciano Carugo” Trophie is not responsible in case of accidents or other facts that could occur during the tournament. Therefore, the players and the team staff must be insured by their Society or Club.

In any case, medical assistance will be assured during the tournament course.

ART. 10

Complains for presumed technical mistakes made by the match officers will not be admitted.

ART.11

The organising committee has issued a so-called "discipline plate". The plate will be assigned to the team that will have accumulated at the end of the tournament the least number of penalties, applied as follows:

ATHLETES

- personal foul : 1 penalty
- technical foul : 2 penalties
- expulsion foul : 4 penalties

COACH AND TEAM STAFF

- technical foul : 3 penalties
- expulsion foul : 5 penalties

ART. 12

All the teams and the relevant members participating to the competition commit themselves to be present at the award and closing ceremony that will be celebrated in the gymnasium where the final matches will be played.

Those rules not included in this regulation must be considered in force by the Executive Regulation of the F.I.B.A..
